Emergency Transfer Policy

Towheed Iranian School

 The school clinic is equipped with the appropriate medical equipment, supplies, and pharmacological agents which are required in order to provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and other emergency services.

 Written policies ensure necessary personnel, equipment, and procedures to handle medical and other emergencies that way arise in connection with services provided, there is protocols for handling emergency situations, including medical emergencies and internal disasters. • There is a written protocol in place for the timely and safe transfer of patients to a pre-specified alternate care facility within a reasonable proximity when extended or emergency services are needed. A team of school nurse, school doctor, teacher, supervisor and administrator are developed.
The policies reviewed on regular basis and kept updated.

Emergency Type 1 : High level of emergency which needs referrals to the secondary care level (hospital or health center)

Emergency type 2 : low level of emergency which can be managed at school setting at parents consents.
